As secretary of Morgan High School, Miss Little is an essential part of the administration. She runs the office, selling game tickets, checking in students, and handling all of the correspondence.



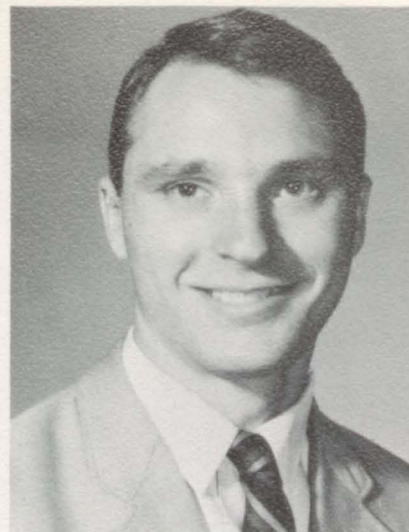

Brad Shaw, sports editor, did a fine job on the sports section. He also spent many hours in the dark room in helping with the ads.


