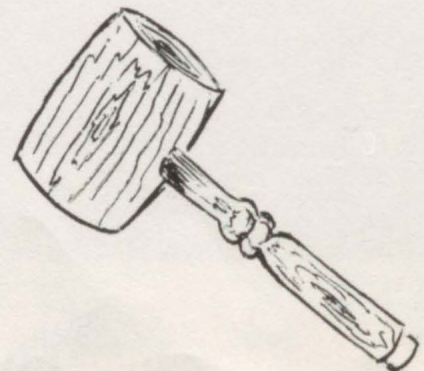

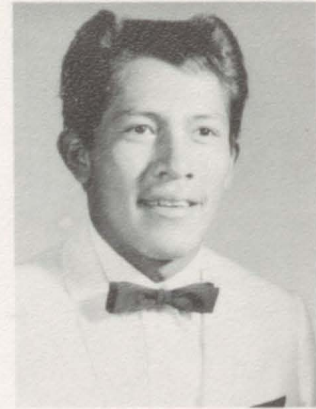
Matinee dances, "Big Sister" parties, assemblies, are all ways the Girls' League promotes friendship, interest, and co-operation.



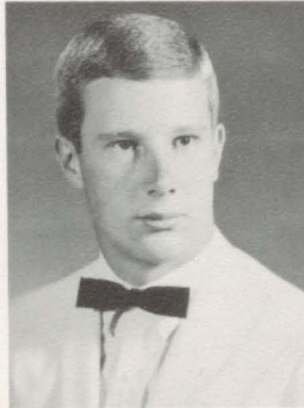

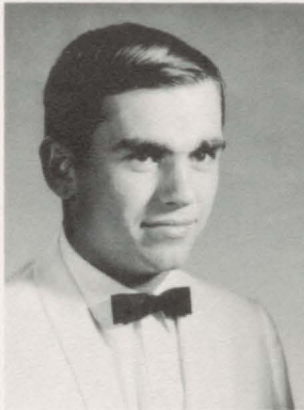

The National Honor Society hopes to see students excel and strives to give recognition to students who earn the right to become members.

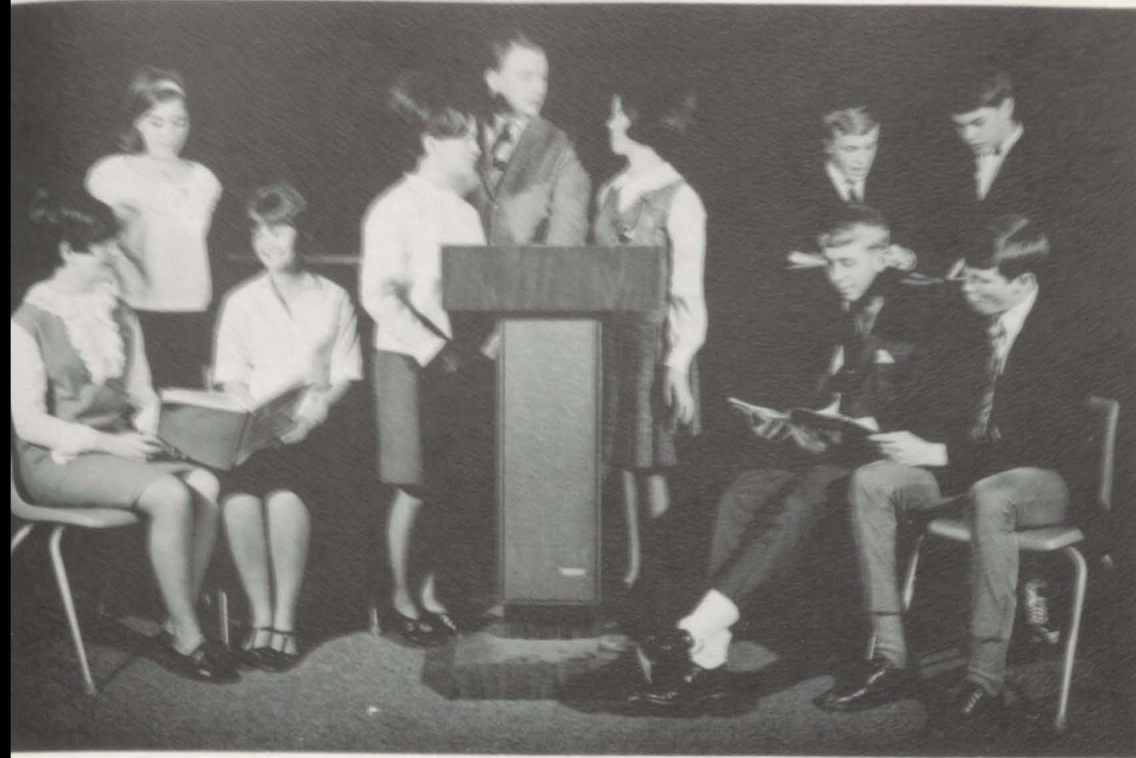
# F.T.A.

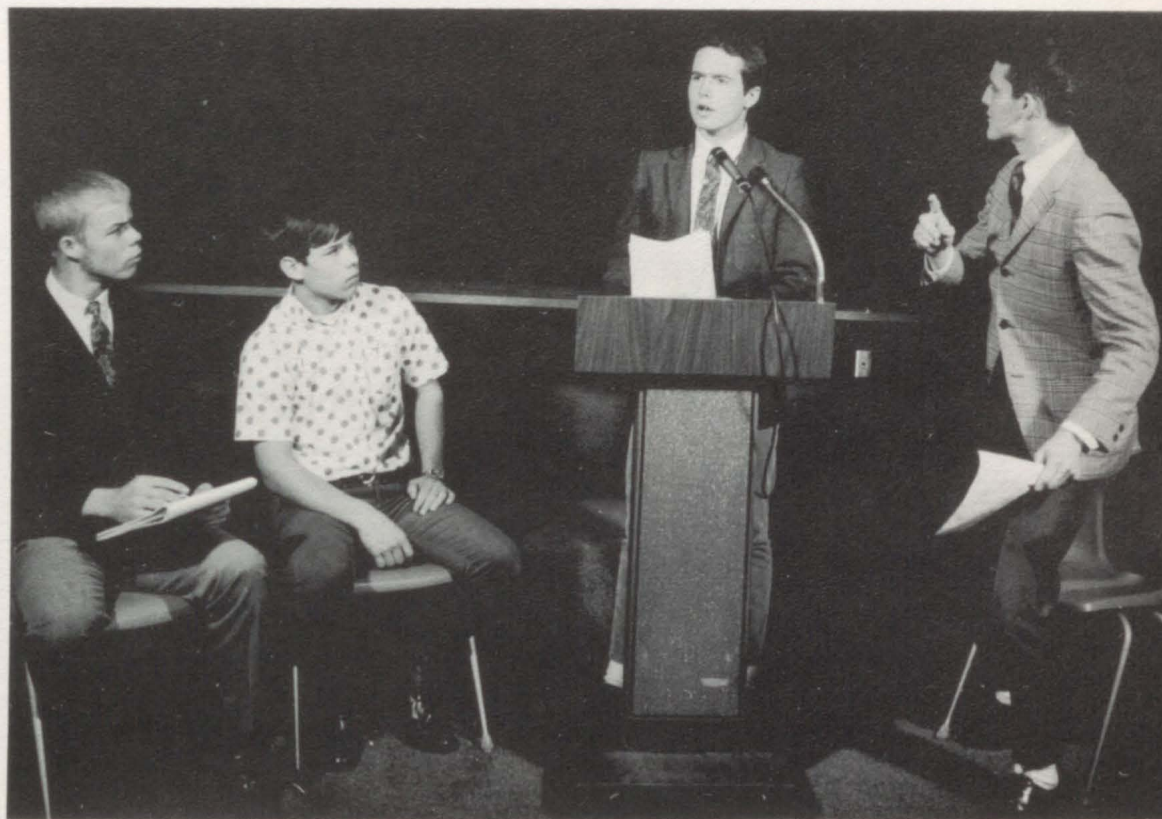

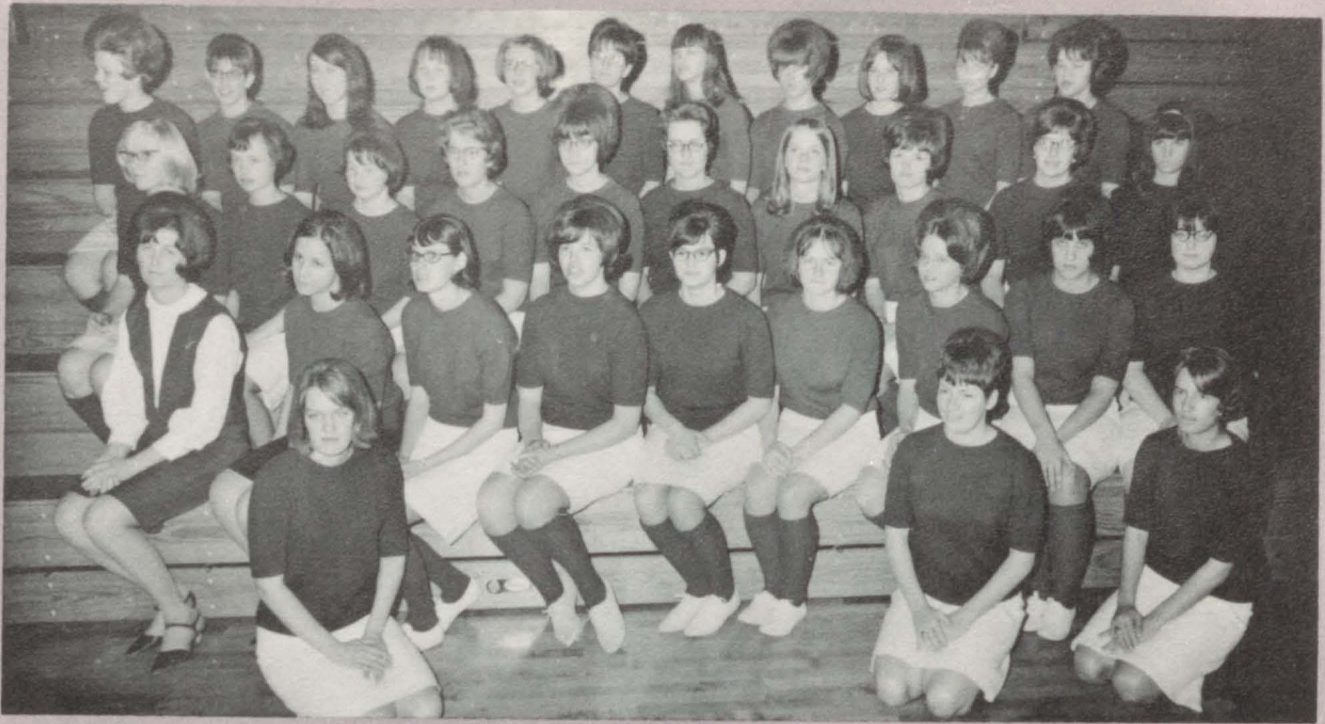
Norway seems a little closer and a little more important to many students at Morgan this year. Morgan's Model United Nation members represented her at the mock United Nations in Salt Lake City.

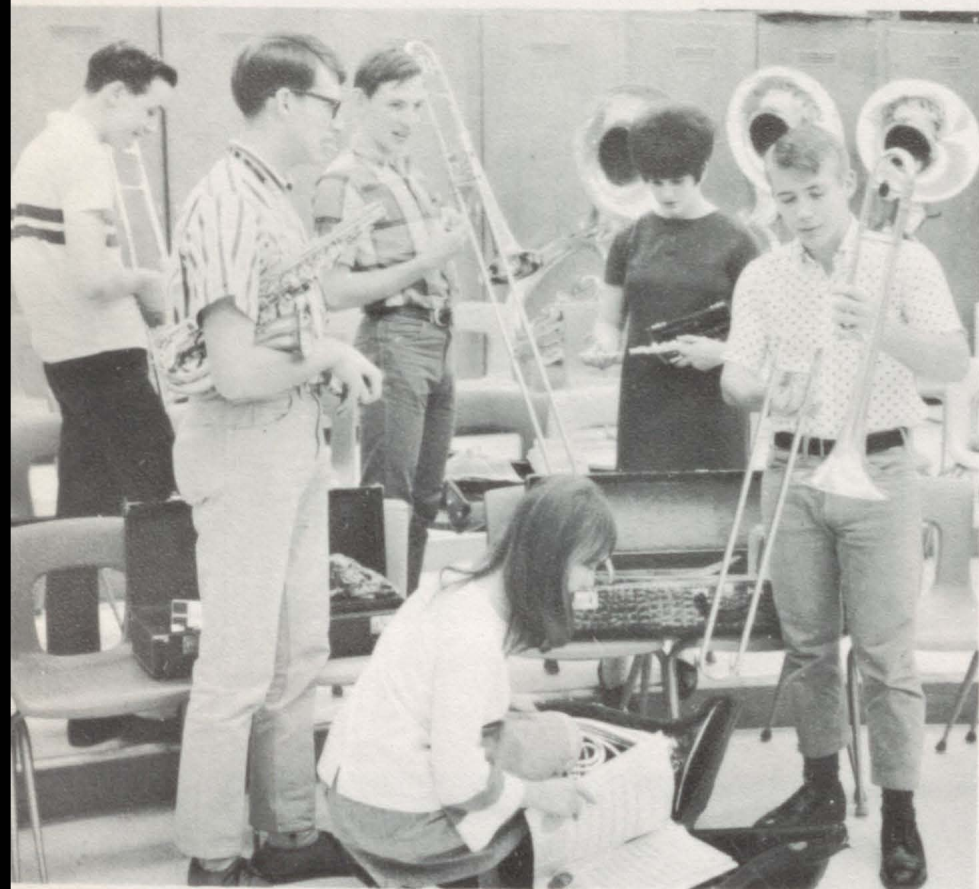
