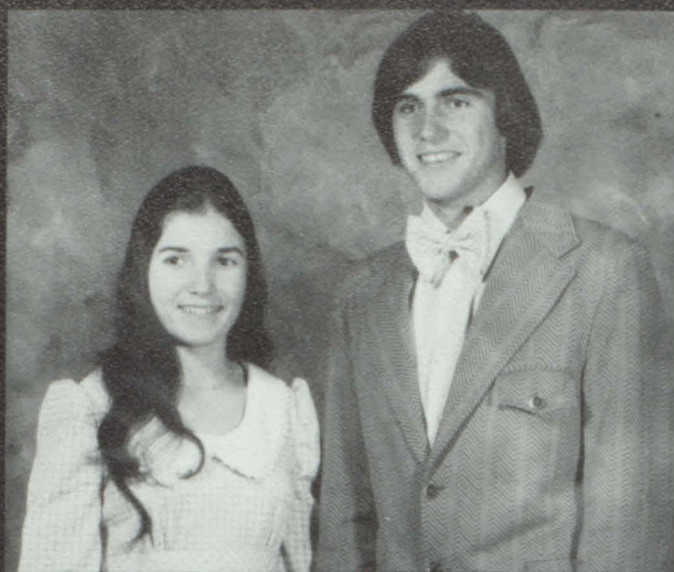
# Seniors of the Month

Leon Waldron held the position of senior class president this year. He has also participated in symphonic band, stage band, A cappella choir, Ski Club, and baseball.

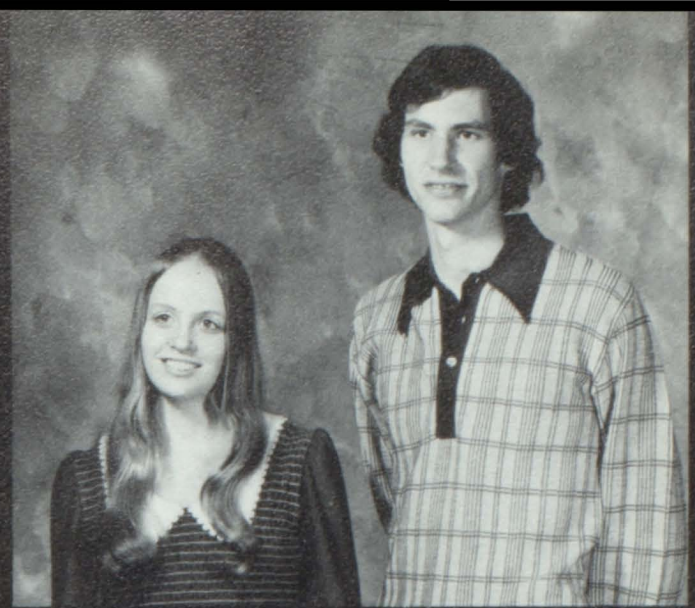
Student Body President Scott Whittier was chosen Senior of the Month for January. He has also been active in track, basketball, A cappella choir, band, stage band, and Honor Society.

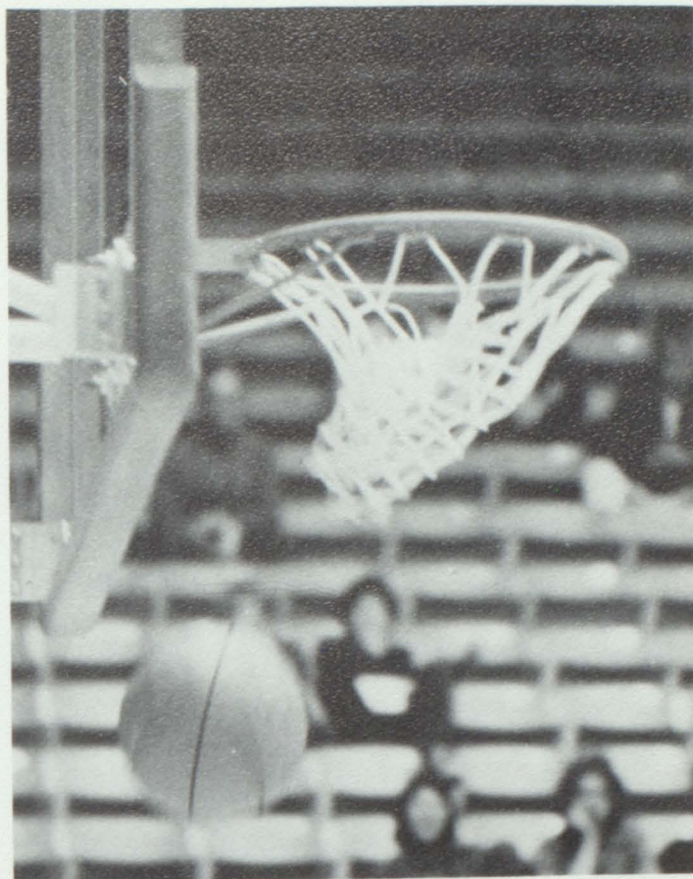
